7 Steps to Compliance Guide

STEP 1 Know your duties

Download Part 2 of The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 05
From www.opsi.gov.uk/si/si2005/20051541.htm and read it.

STEP 2 Obtain Government Guidance for your type of premises

Download and read www.communities.gov.uk

STEP 3 Decide if you need outside help/specialist advice

If you don't feel you have the knowledge and expertise to carry out the assessment, you can appoint an outside person to help e.g. Health & Safety Consultants, Fire Safety Specialists, check they have the right level of competence to undertake the job.

STEP 4 Carry out your risk assessment

Work methodically around the premises taking into consideration all possible sources of ignition and combustion, and how evacuation may be impeded by current working practises. Record and action your findings.

STEP5 Develop a Fire Safety Management System

Set up routines for the inspection & record keeping of all fire safety equipment and fire drills.

STEP 6 Maintain the Fire Safety Management System

Carry out the inspections and have fire drills to ensure all staff Know where to assemble etc.

STEP 7 Review the Risk Assessment

Periodically or following changes or incidents to make sure know Hazards are being over looked.
